#### **GENERAL INFORMATION**

The President of Zoological Society of Pakistan and the Congress Organizing Committee cordially invite the Fellows/Members of the Society and all other scientists interested in various disciplines of Zoological Sciences to take part in the 33r<sup>rd</sup> Pakistan Congress of Zoology to be held at the Pakistan Museum Natural History, Islamabd on **April 2 to 4, 2013.** 

#### SCIENTIFIC PROGRAMME

The scientific programme will consist of plenary lectures and oral presentations. Theme of the Congress will cover all the major areas of Zoology and related disciplines e.g. Entomology and Pest Management; Cell Biology, Molecular Biology, Bioinformatics, Environmental Biotechnology, Bioremediation, Genetics, Toxicology, Parasitology; Microbiology, Physiology; Palaeontology, Environmental Biology, Wild Life Conservation; Fisheries, Freshwater Biology and Marine Biology.

There will be three sessions each day. The first session will start at 9.00 A.M. The paper reading session will start immediately after inauguration and will continue till the 3rd day. Fifteen minutes will be allowed for presentation of paper and discussion. Multimedia and 2x2 slide projectors will be available.

The participants are reminded that only one paper will be accepted for presentation from one set of authors.

Last date for the receipt of registration forms and abstracts of papers is February 28, 2013.

#### **ABSTRACTS**

The participants are requested to submit two copies of abstracts of their research papers. The abstracts should include a brief introduction, methods used, main results and conclusions. References should not included in the text of Abstract. Multimedia, 2x2 slide and overhead projectors will be available.

#### **POSTER SESSION**

Poster session, as usual, has been arranged specially for the younger scientists. A committee will review the posters and adjudge the first, second and third best posters. The authors of these posters will be given certificates at the Closing Ceremony on the third day of the Congress.

Participants desirous of presenting poster must, however, register themselves for the congress and submit a short summary by February 28, 2013.

#### PAKISTAN MUSEUM OF NATURAL HISTORY, ISLAMABAD

Pakistan Museum of Natural History (PMNH) situated at Garden Avenue, Shakarparian, Islamabad was established in 1976 under the patronage of Pakistan Science Foundation, Ministry of Science & Technology (Government of Pakistan). It has four principal divisions namely Botanical Sciences Division, Zoological Sciences Division, Earth Sciences Division and Public Services Division. The first three divisions are engaged in the collection, identification and research activities pertaining to plants, animals and mineral resources of Pakistan respectively, while the latter is responsible for mass education and popularization of natural history various displays, exhibits and dioramas. In addition various projects such as Virtual Orientation Gallery (VOG), Biodiversity Database and Global Networking (BGN) and Focus Baluchistan have also been initiated.

The distinction of PMNH lies not only in research but also in implementing mass education and awareness about conservation of biodiversity and environmental issues through 3-dimensional displays and dioramas, a source of attraction for all ages, children and adults, illiterate or the professional scholars. The scientific information is translated in the form of an easy-to-understand and attractive medium so that the information not only reaches general public but is also easily understood and digested by them. Usually such mass communication medium is in the form of 3-dimensional diorama, which are visually quite

There are more than 30 scientists and designers who are engaged in research primarily pertaining to the biodiversity of Pakistan with special reference to environment and natural habitat degradation. A large number of natural history specimens (plants, animals, rocks, minerals and fossils) have already been collected and curated. PMNH scientists have discovered a number of new Plants and animal species. PMNH scientists have published a number of research articles in journals of international repute. Highly productive collaboration research programmes with many foreign countries are in progress, such as those with USA, UK, Japan and Italy. France, Switzerland.. PMNH has Display Galleries in which a number of dioramas and other exhibits are displayed. We regularly publish natural history brouchures, leaflets, bulletins and posters etc. for mass education. Symposia / Workshops about latest natural history issues are regularly held at PMNH. We have helped in setting-up of many other musea, such as NMST, Lahore, Maritime Museum, Karachi and Children Complex, Lahore.

- The ninth Ahmed Mohiuddin Memorial Gold Medal will be awarded to a student of University of Sindh, Jamshoro standing first in the recent M.Sc. Zoology examination.
- The ninth **Prof. Dr. S.N.H. Naqvi Gold Medal** will be awarded to successful Ph.D. Zoology specializing in the field of Toxicology from University of Karachi.
- The fifth Afsar Mian Gold Medal will be awarded to a student of University of Arid Agriculture, Rawalpindi standing first in the recent M.Sc. Zoology examination.

The tenth **Professor A.R. Shakoori Gold Medal** will be given to a young researcher upto the age of 45 in any area of Biological Sciences. A specially constituted committee will scrutinize the applications received in response to an advertisement. The Medal will be conferred during the Inaugural session of 33<sup>rd</sup> Pakistan Congress of Zoology.

#### PROF. DR. MIRZA AZHAR BEG GOLD MEDAL

The eleventh **Prof. Dr. Mirza Azhar Beg Gold Medal** will be given to a young researcher upto the age of 45 in Ecology / Wildlife / Vertebrate Pest Management / Taxonomy / Fisheries. A specially constituted committee will scrutinize the applications received in response to an advertisement. The Medal will be conferred during the Inaugural session of 33<sup>rd</sup> Pakistan Congress of Zoology.

#### PROF. IMTIAZAHMAD GOLD MEDAL

The first **Prof. Imtiaz Ahmed Gold Medal** will be given to researcher in the field of Entomology. A specially constituted committee will scrutinize the applications received in response to an advertisement. The Medal will be conferred during the Inaugural session of 33<sup>rd</sup> Pakistan Congress of Zoology.

#### PROF. DR. NASIMA M. TIRMIZI GOLD MEDAL

The seventh **Prof. Dr. Nasima M. Tirmizi Gold Medal** will be given to a researcher in the field of Marine Sciences. A specially constituted committee will scrutinize the applications received in response to an advertisement. The Medal will be conferred during the Inaugural session of 33<sup>rd</sup> Pakistan Congress of Zoology.

#### INSTRUCTIONS FOR POSTER PRESENTATIONS


Abstracts scheduled for presentation in poster sessions will be grouped by topic, numbered and listed in the programme, and published in the abstract book in the usual manner. In addition, programme listings will specify time when your colleagues may expect you to be at your assigned space to discuss your work.

Mount posters on your assigned board in the evening of April 1, 2013, *i.e.* one day before the inauguration of the Congress. Posters should be in place for the full congress period.

The poster board surface is 3'8" high and 5'6" wide. Prepare for the top of your poster space a label indicating its title and authors. The lettering for this section should not be less than 1" high. A copy of your abstract typed in large type, should be posted in the upper left-hand corner of the poster board.

All illustrations should be made beforehand. Keep in mind that your illustrations must be read by interested scientists from distances of about 3' or more. Charts, drawings and illustrations might well be similar to those you would otherwise use in making slides; preferably cruder and more heavily drawn. They need not, in fact should not, be "arty." Simple use of color can add emphasis effectively. Do not mount them on heavy board because these may be difficult to keep in position on the poster boards. Hand lettered material should contain appropriately heavy lettering at least 3/8" high. Shade block letters where possible. Typed material should be typed on a Bulletin (large type) typewriter, if possible. Keep illustrative material simple.

#### Bring your own push-pins or thumbtacks.




#### ISLAMABAD

Islamabad is the capital of Pakistan, it is located at 33.43°N 73.04°E in the foot of the Margalla Hills. Its elevation is 540 meters. Climate of Islamabad is humid subtropical, with warm and dry springs, hot and humid summers accompanied by a monsoon season, and brief but cool winters. The average temperature in the month of April is 30-15 °C. Islamabad is a most beautiful place for tourism. Museums, Faisal Mosque, Maraghzar Zoo, Daman e Koh, Rawal Lake and Shaker Parrian are tourist places of Islamabad.

Islamabad boasts the highest literacy rate in Pakistan at 87%, and has most advanced educational institutes in the country. A large number of public and private sector educational institutes are present here. The higher education institutes in the capital are either federally chartered or administered by private organizations and almost all of them are recognized by the Higher Education Commission of Pakistan.

Islamabad is connected to major destinations around the world through Benazir Bhutto International Airport. All major cities and towns are accessible through regular trains and bus services running mostly from the neighboring city of Rawalpindi. Lahore and Peshawar are linked to Islamabad through a network of motorways which has resulted in a significant reduction in travelling times between these cities. M-2 Motorway is 367 km long and connects Islamabad and Lahore. M-1 Motorway connects Islamabad with Peshawar and is 155 km long. PMNH can be accessed from M1 and M2 through Kashmir Highway.
