**Use of molecular-genetic and morphological methods to study the taxonomy,
phylogeny, biogeography, and ecology of *Eurytemora* species**

The conference is a joint effort between all over the world researchers, and it aims to provide a forum for sharing results regarding *Eurytemora*, a key zooplankton genus member. The gathering will also facilitate discussion of current issues in our field. Oral presentations will be grouped into four Conference Sessions by topic

- Taxonomy
- Phylogeny
- Biogeography
- Ecology
- Taxonomic training

The organizers plan to publish conference proceedings as a special issue in an international journal (to be arranged later). A practical session on *Eurytemora* species identification will be featured. A welcome party, conference dinner, and mid conference break for sightseeing are planned.

Registration fees

You will receive a confirmation after your registration, along with travel and other practical information. If we receive more applications than there is conference capacity, we may have to limit oral presentations. In those cases, presentations of data in poster session will be welcome.

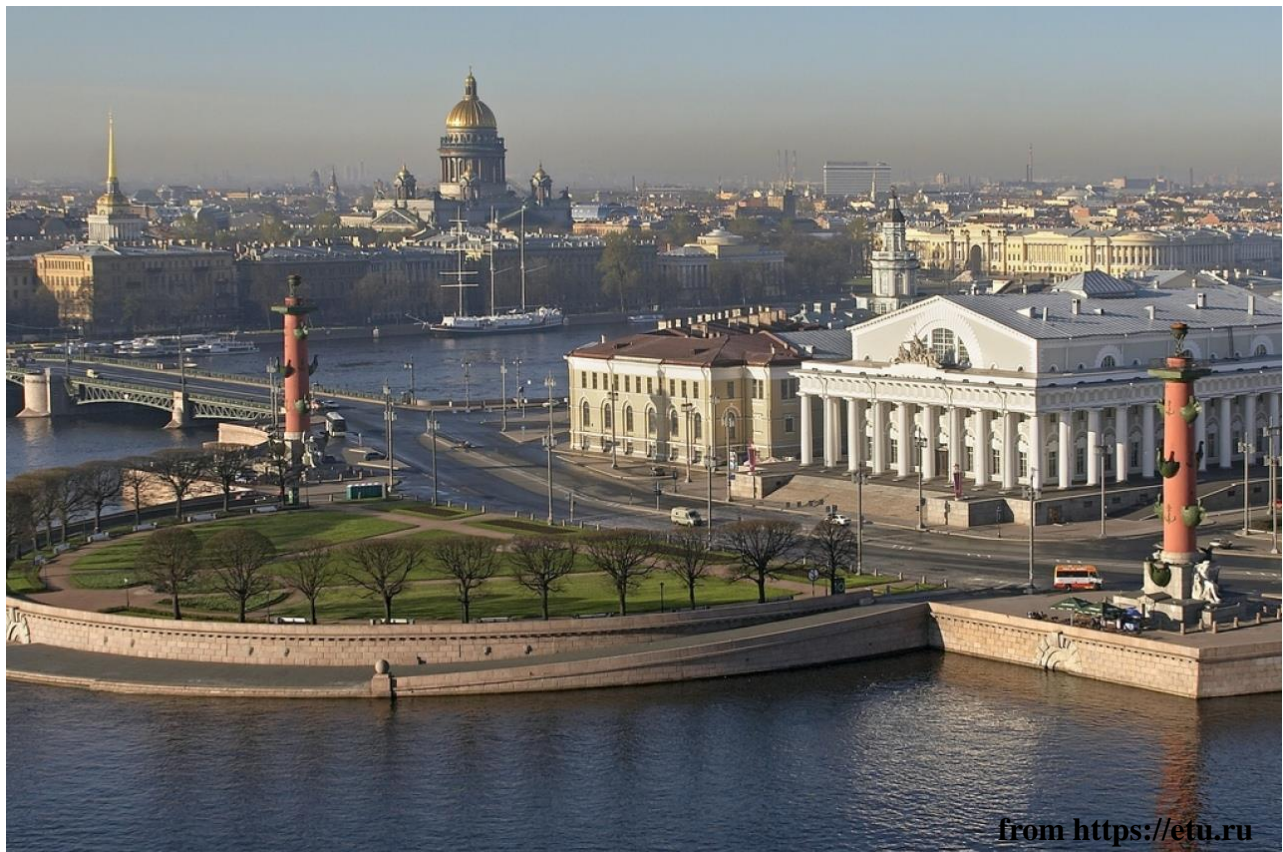
