

## New records of Nabini from Indochina (Heteroptera: Nabidae)

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Twelve species of *Gorpis*, *Stenonabis* and *Nabis* are recorded from Myanmar, Thailand, Laos, and Vietnam for the first time. New synonymy: *Gorpis annulatus* Paiva, 1919 = *G. annulatus brevipennis* Kerzhner, 1970.

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The material used in this paper is kept at Zoological Institute, St.Petersburg, except specimens of *Nabis chinensis*, which are deposited at Naturhistoriska Riksmuseet, Stockholm. Countries from which the species is recorded for the first time are asterisked.

***Gorpis albicans*** Reuter, 1909. \***Thailand**: 1 ♂, Ban Kaeng Krachan, 30-31.VII.1996 (Mostovsky). \***Vietnam**: *Ba Thuoc*: 1 ♀, 125 km W Than Hoa, on tree, 23.I.1989 (Korotyaev); *Gialai Contum*: 2 ♀, Tai Nguen plateau, Kannack, 8-16.XI.1988 (Gorochov); 1 ♀, Buon Loi, 31.XII.1985 (L. Medvedev); 1 ♀, same locality, 15.XII.1988 (Gorochov).

***G. annulatus*** Paiva, 1919 (= *G. annulatus brevipennis* Kerzhner, 1970, syn. n.). \***Vietnam**: *Hoa Binh*: 1 ♀, 40 km W Mai Chau, Po Co, 1090 m, 19-22.IV.2002 (Belokobylskij); *Lao Cai*: 1 ♂, Sa Pa Distr., Fan Si Pan Mt, 1900-2500 m, 20.IV-9.V.1999 (N.L. Orlov); *Vinh Phu*: 1 ♀, Tam Dao, secondary mountainous rain forest, 11-13.V.1975 (L. Medvedev & Dang Dap); 1 ♂, 1 ♀, same locality, ca 1000 m, forest, 10, 16.XI.1990 (Belokobylskij, Sugonjaev). – Note: the brachypterous specimens from Vietnam are intermediate between the typical *G. annulatus* and ssp. *brevipennis* described from Sumatra.

***G. elegans*** Poppius, 1914. \***Vietnam**: *Ha Son Binh*: 1 ♂, 2 ♀, Distr. Da Bac, Tuly, forest with bamboo, 22.X.1990 (Belokobylskij).

***G. humeralis*** (Distant, 1914). \***Vietnam**: *Vinh Phu*: 1 ♀, Tam Dao, secondary mountainous rain forest, 11-13.V.1975 (L. Medvedev & Dang Dap).

***G. liniolipes*** Hsiao, 1981. \***Vietnam**: *Ha Son Binh*: 1 ♀, Region Hoa Binh, Distr. Mai Chou, village Mai Chou, forest, 31.X.1990 (Belokobylskij); *Vinh Phu*: 3 ♂, Tam Dao, 700 m, pine forest, 14.XI.1990 (Belokobylskij).

***G. longispinis*** Harris, 1939. \***Vietnam**: *Gialai Contum*: 1 ♀, 20 km N Buon Loi, 21-30.XI.1988 (Gorochov); 1 ♀, Tai Nguen plateau, Kannack, 8-16.XI.1988 (Gorochov); *Ha Son Binh*: 1 ♀, Distr. Da Bac, Tuly, forest, 23.X.1990 (Belokobylskij); 1 ♀, 1 ♀, Distr. Ky Son, Cao Phong, forest, 23, 27.X.1990 (Belokobylskij, Gorochov).

***Stenonabis hainanus*** Ren & Hsiao, 1981. \***Thailand**: 1 ♂, 1 ♀, Chaiaphum, Phu Khiso Wildlife Sanctuary, 9-11.VI.1984 (Matti Hämäläinen). \***Vietnam**: *Gialai Contum*: 2 ♂, 7 ♀, Buon Luoi, 35 km N An Khe, 14-20.VI.1982 (Darevsky).

***S. macgillavryi*** (Poppius, 1914). \***Vietnam**: *Gialai Contum*: 1 ♀, Buon Luoi, 35 km N An Khe, 14-20.VI.1982 (Darevsky).

***S. roseisignis*** Ren & Hsiao, 1981. \***Vietnam**: *Ha Son Binh*: 1 ♂, Distr. Da Bac, Tuly, 6.X.1990 (Sugonjaev); 1 ♂, Da Bac, 16.X.1990 (Nartshuk).

***S. tagalicus tagalicus*** (Stål, 1860). \***Laos**: 3 ♀, Vientiane, at light, 20.I-1.II.1986 (Kabakov). \***Vietnam**: *Ha Son Binh*: 2 ♂, Distr. Da Bac, Tuly, forest, 6.X.1990 (Sugonjaev); *Shon La*: 1 ♂, 1 ♀, Shong Ma, 1-14.V.1986 (Gorochov).

***S. tibialis*** (Distant, 1904). \***Laos**: 4 ♀, Vientiane, at light, 21.X.1984, 20.I-1.II.1986 (Kabakov). \***Vietnam**: *Ba Thuoc*: 1 ♂, 125 km W Than Hoa, flood-land, in litter, 29.I.1989 (Korotyaev).

***Nabis chinensis*** Ren & Hsiao, 1981. \***Myanmar** (“NE Burma”): 1 ♂, 2 ♀, Kambaiti, 7000 ft, 19.IV. and V.1934 (R. Malaise). – Note. Chinese authors (Ren & Hsiao, 1981; Ren, 1998) erroneously consider *N. chinensis* to be a subspecies of the West Palaearctic *N. pseudoferus* Remane; actually, these species have nothing in common and the closest relative of *N. chinensis* is *N. hsiaoai* Kerzhner, 1992 (*nigrovittatus* Ren, 1981) from the Himalayas.
