Family Psychodidae

Note. Abkhazia (Abk) is distinguished as a part of Georgia and mentioned when the species was recorded in Georgia only from this part. *Berdeniella caucasica* Wagner, 1981 was erroneously reported from Georgia. The correct locality is Teberda in Russia (Karachay-Cherkess Republic in the North Caucasus). On the other hand, *Philosepedon (Philosepedon) wagneri* Omelková et Ježek, 2012 and *Ph. (Trichosepedon) atschitaricum* Vaillant et Joost, 1983 are known only from “Western Caucasus”, however, the exact localities are unclear.
