

A new replacement name for *Darwinella* Enderlein, 1912 (Coleoptera: Tenebrionoidea: Perimylopidae)

A new replacement name *Pseudodarwinella* is proposed for *Darwinella* Enderlein, 1912, a junior homonym of *Darwinella* Müller, 1865 (Porifera).

Key words: Coleoptera, Tenebrionoidea, Perimylopidae, *Darwinella*, *Pseudodarwinella*, new replacement name

According to Articles 52.4, 53, 56.1 and 60 of the International Code of Zoological Nomenclature (International Commission on Zoological Nomenclature, 1999) (the Code), a junior homonym must be rejected and replaced either by an available and potentially valid synonym or, for lack of such a name, by a new substitute name. I found no potentially available and valid synonyms for *Darwinella* Enderlein, 1912 and suppose that I am able to use Art. 60.3 of the Code.

Thus, a new replacement name *Pseudodarwinella* is proposed below for *Darwinella* Enderlein, 1912 (Coleoptera: Tenebrionoidea: Perimylopidae), a junior homonym of *Darwinella* Müller, 1865 (Porifera: Demospongiae: Dendroceratida: Darwinellidae).

Pseudodarwinella nom. nov.

Darwinella Enderlein, 1912: 14.

Type species: *Darwinella amaroides* Enderlein, 1912.

Etymology. The name *Pseudodarwinella* consists of the Greek prefix “pseudo” (falsely) and the generic name *Darwinella* Enderlein, 1912. Gender: feminine.

Pseudodarwinella amaroides (Enderlein, 1912), new combination
