Lectotypes are designated for five nominal species of *Aelia* and *Neottiglossa*.

In this paper, lectotypes are designated for some species of the Palaearctic Aeliini (Pentatomidae). The specimens are kept at the Museum National d'Histoire Naturelle, Paris (MNHN) and Muzeul de Istorie Naturala "Grigore Antipa", Bucharest (MGAB). Type labels added by the authors are not cited. The following abbreviations are used: h – handwritten label; p – printed label. All specimens under consideration are pinned ones.

Aelia cognata Fieber, 1868

Lectotype (coll. Noualhier, MNHN): ♀, "Type Fieber" [h], "Type" [p, red].

Aelia cribrosa Fieber, 1868

Lectotype (coll. Puton, MNHN): ♀, green square, "Escorial" [h].

Aelia furcula Fieber, 1868

Lectotype (coll. Puton, MNHN): ♂, white square, "♂" [p], "Sarepta" [h].

Aelia henschi Montandon, 1886

Lectotype (coll. Montandon, MGAB): ♂, "Gorice, Illyrie [h], Schreiber leg. [p]".

Synonym of *Ae. sibirica* Reuter, 1884.

Pentatoma lineolata Mulsant & Rey, 1852

Lectotype (coll. Mulsant, MNHN): ♂, "Museum Paris, 1943, coll. E. Mulsant" [p].

Paralectotype (coll. Mulsant, MNHN): ♀, "Museum Paris, 1943, coll. E. Mulsant" [p].

Current name: *Neottiglossa lineolata* (Mulsant & Rey, 1852).
